There are some things that we feel are important for all students to have. We have tried to be sensitive with costs, but if buying any of these is difficult, we have some supplies available to help out. If you wait to buy supplies near the end of the summer, most stores have good sales on very affordable supplies.

Please bring to school on the first day:

- one binder/organizer for keeping an assignment book and important papers
- a good supply of pens and pencils
- a package or two of 3x3 post-it notes
- a highlighter
- a single-subject spiral notebook for each class
- a two pocket folder or 1 ½ inch binder for each class
- A calculator with positive and negative keys
- earbuds or headphones

The following would be nice to have if you are able, but some of these items are also available in classrooms:

- an assignment book/planner
- ruler with standard and metric units
- small scissors
- colored pencils and markers
- glue stick
- cap erasers

Please keep in mind that backpacks with wheels do not fit into school lockers.

When clothes shopping for the fall, it might be wise to consult the school's dress code beforehand. (found in the school handbook).
